Burbayarmonkeys, coaties, tapirs, agoutis, deer, pumas, jaguars Little Hermit, Garden Emerald, Rufous-tailed Hummingbird, Black Throated Mango or parrots including the Mealy Amazon, Brown-hooded Parrot and Blue-headed Parrot Keel-billed Toucan Collared Aracari; Golden-hooded Tanager, Sulphur-rumped Tanager, Summer Tanager Flame-rumped Tanager Sapayoa, Speckled Antshrike, Black-faced Antthrush, Black-headed Antthrush, Black-crowned Antpitta, Streak-chested Antpitta, Yellow-eared Toucanet, Green Hermit.

Bocas del Toro ArchipelagoSergeant Major, Green Moray, Gray Angelfish, and several different species of Damselfish and Parrotfish can be observed, sea anemones, long-spine sea urchin, sea star, leafy stinging coral, bristle worm, and tube sponge. West Indian manatee, Bottle Nosed Dolphin, Hawksbill Sea Turtle, Leatherback Sea Turtle, Green Sea Turtle, Howler Monkey, Tucans, lobsters, crabs, octopus, cuttlefish, nurse sharks, remoras, eels, stingrays, electric rays, manta rays, different species of reptiles and amphibians.
